

Curating Curiosities: A Community Visual Arts Exhibit

Thank you for your interest in displaying your artwork at JUMP. Curating Curiosities is a community visual arts exhibit in the JUMP Lobby that gives the public a chance to view local artwork of different types including paintings, drawings and photography. We invite participating artists to be present to meet with the public during First Thursdays in the Lobby, and to share their inspiration and background with the community during a Connecting Community presentation and Q and A in the Inspire Studio. Local artists of all levels and backgrounds are invited to submit works of art that will be displayed in the JUMP Lobby for approximately three weeks.

All exhibits will be approved and scheduled by JUMP. All artwork must be able to hang in approved areas: we offer up to 35 spaces (22.5" wide x approximately 77" high) to hang art. All art must be hung with some version of a 3M command strip (purchased by artist) – lighter weight pieces work best. Please visit our lobby during open hours to see examples.
