STEAMROLLER PRINT PROJECT

[Jack's Urban Meeting Place](#) and [WingTip Press](#) received a grant from [Idaho Commission on the Arts](#) to do a Steamroller Print Project for the 2018 Day of the Dead/Día de Muertos celebration. If you are an experienced printmaker or a novice who wants to try wood block printing on a large scale, this project is for you.

Participating artists will design, create and print a large scale banner that is inspired by Día de Muertos, a vibrant Latin American holiday that remembers and honors loved ones who have passed. The banner will be hung at JUMP during the November 1st Día de Muertos Steamroller celebration and mounted for a procession around downtown Boise. Interested artists should contact Amy Nack at Wingtip Press (info@wingtippress.com) to reserve a spot and learn more details of the process.

Participants will be required to provide their own piece of 4' x 8' mdf and there will be various Print Project Meet Up times (see below) where participants can use our space and carving tools for free. Participants will deliver their printing block to JUMP on October 19th or 20th, and provide at least two hours assistance at the steamroller printing party held at JUMP on Saturday, October 20th.
