

POSITION | JUMP Slide Activator (Temporary Position: June-September)

POSITION DESCRIPTION

The JUMP Slide Activator works collaboratively with all JUMP team members to build and sustain a strong team culture at JUMP that supports the JUMP mission. Reporting to the Volunteer Coordinator, the Slide Activator is responsible for helping to ensure a safe, healthy, and supportive environment for all slide riders. This person assists with and explains the proper approach to using the slides, and engages visitors by creating a fun, warm, welcoming, and supportive environment to ensure a positive experience. It's important that all Slide Activators show kindness, compassion, and empathy, especially towards participants who may be nervous or uncomfortable attempting the slide for the first time.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Distributes a slide bag and instructs slide riders on the proper method for entering and riding the slide.
- Checks to ensure riders meet all criteria for riding slides including height and weight requirements.
- Locks, unlocks, and conducts an inspection to ensure the slide is clean and in proper working condition.
- Ensures that the rider has fully exited before another rider is allowed onto the slide.
- Assists in emergencies by shutting down the slide operations, helping to clear the area if needed, controlling by-standers, and providing additional assistance as directed by security or JUMP Team members.
- Coordinate set-up of slide program by gathering slide bags and setting up stanchions and appropriate signage.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be at least 15 years old.
- Ability to work nights and weekends as necessary.
- Ability to hear commands in a noisy environment.
- Strong verbal communication skills with the ability to effectively maintain a controlled environment and convey the JUMP mission.
- Must be able to sit or stand for prolonged periods of time in an outdoors environment with unpredictable weather.
- Possess a positive and outgoing personality with attention to detail.
- Problem solving skills and the ability to take initiative that allow quick and effective decision making.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS

- CPR certified
- Knowledge of and experience in non-profit organizations
- Knowledge of the local community
